People who have diabetes need to take special care of their feet to avoid calluses, blisters, ulcers and other injuries that can lead to serious complications. Improper footwear often causes these types of injuries in patients with diabetes, resulting in more than 54,000 diabetes-related amputations each year in the United States. For this reason, people with diabetes who are experiencing any foot pain or problems should consult with their physician immediately.

DIABETIC FOOTWEAR

Because prevention is the best cure, Medicare established a diabetic footwear benefit. Specially designed shoes can lower the incidence of foot injuries that lead to more serious complications. Persons with Type I or Type II diabetes are eligible for one pair of diabetic shoes and three pairs of inserts per calendar year. Diabetics who have no history of foot complications also may be eligible.
